Fire Alarm maintenance

Fire Alarm design, supply, install & commission

Once you have had a fire risk assessment, which identifies the system requirements we can design, supply, install, commission and maintain a wide range of fire alarm systems. We can install the latest wireless systems, which eliminates the need for wiring throughout the building. Fully qualified technicians will install your new system with minimum disruption to your business. Our installation work is carried out to the highest standards. Following your fire alarm installation, we provide training in the operation of the alarm system to the appropriate people.

Gas suppression systems

If you have a computer room or data center you may be required to have an automatic gas suppression system. We are able to provide the supply, installation, commissioning and on-going maintenance to the current standards.

24/7 monitoring

We provide monitoring of fire alarm systems via EMCS; one of the UK's largest independent monitoring stations. Using communicators, such as Dual Comm, signals from these systems are sent within seconds, alerting you of an activation.



Emergency Light Design, supply, install & commission

Once you have had a fire risk assessment, which identifies the requirements we can design, supply, install and commission a range of self-contained, high-efficiency emergency lights in both functional and decorative versions. We can also provide central battery powered systems. Our design personnel are able to provide technical advice and product selection. The size and type of your premises and the risk to the occupants will determine the complexity of the emergency lighting required.

Emergency Lighting maintenance

Emergency lighting requires testing at regular intervals. This can be annually or more frequently if required. Emergency lighting can be 'maintained' (on at all times), or 'non-maintained' (Off and only operates when normal lighting fails). Emergency lights should operate for one, two or three hours, depending on the application but in practice most emergency lights are three hours. Emergency lights will also provide some use in the premises during a power failure other than in an emergency.
